

101 Years of Rolfe, Iowa, Newspapers at Your (Online) Fingertips!

If I could have at my fingertips the Rolfe, Iowa, newspapers spanning 101 years from 1888 to 1989, the first thing I would look up would be _____.

If you mentally filled in the above blank, you are in store for a treat!

The Rolfe, Iowa, newspapers used to be available on microfilm at the Rolfe Public Library. The library's microfilm reader needed repair; therefore, the microfilm rolls were moved to the Pocahontas Public Library where they still reside.

Hello to 101 years of the Rolfe, Iowa, newspapers on the Internet!!!

Recently there was a drive to digitize (transfer from audiocassettes to CDs) 110 oral history interviews of people living in Rolfe during 1980-81. Funds were raised via sponsorships, donations, and sales of prints of watercolors by Marion Gunderson. Although some tapes are yet to be sponsored, the funds raised surpassed the amount needed to digitize all the tapes.*

Because of the tremendous support of the oral history drive, funds raised from sales of prints will be redirected toward making 101 years of Rolfe newspapers available online. The overall cost of this newspaper project is just shy of \$4,000, half of which is already raised.

Rolfe newspapers from July 19, 1888, through September 28, 1989, are currently on 33 rolls of microfilm. (There may be missing issues.) Once there is adequate funding, the microfilm will be digitized.

Once the digitizing is completed, at the Rolfe newspaper web site you will be able to type keywords, including topics and names. If the search engine locates articles/captions/ads, etc. that include the words you typed, you will be able to see the related information on the computer monitor. You may also search by year. (For example, if you type "girls basketball" and specify "1971," you will find the 1971 Rolfe newspaper contents that include the words "girls basketball.") You may also browse the online newspapers in the same manner in which microfilm is browsed.

How May I Help with a Donation?

Q. What is a suggested donation amount? A. Any amount is appreciated. (With the oral histories, donations ranged from \$10 to several hundred dollars.)

Q. How do I go about donating? A. Contribute cash or write a check payable to "Rolfe Public Library Trust." (The word "Trust" is important to include.) On the memo line of your check or in a separate note, indicate "newspaper project." Leave your donation at the library or mail it to the Rolfe Public Library, 317 Garfield St., Rolfe, Iowa, 50581. (If possible, use the form located on the third page of this document.)

Q. May I sponsor an entire roll(s) of microfilm? A. Yes. It is optional to specify the ID #(s) of the roll(s) on your check. ID #s are indicated in the table below. The sponsorship amount per roll is \$115. Multiple sponsorships for rolls will be accepted. (Please be aware that there may be issues missing.**)

Q. Will my donation be publicized? A. The intent will be to maintain anonymity (although that is difficult to guarantee) unless requested otherwise.

Q. Will my donation be tax deductible? A. Yes. The Rolfe Public Library Trust is associated with the City of Rolfe, which has a 501(c)(3) nonprofit status.

Q. When will the newspapers be online? A. The target date is February 2011.
